**RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND IMPOSING WATER AND WASTEWATER
CAPACITY CHARGES TO BE CHARGED BY THE MARIPOSA PUBLIC UTILITY
DISTRICT, EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 1, 2020**

Supersedes Water Connection Fee Resolution No. 91-1130
and Sewer Connection Fee Ordinance No. 33

WHEREAS, the Mariposa Public Utility District (District) provides public water, wastewater and fire protection services to the town of Mariposa; and

WHEREAS, the District's Board of Directors must fix charges for commodities or services furnished by any of its revenue producing utilities as well as pay all of the expenses of the Government of the District or such portion as the Board determines justly apportionable to such utility; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors finds that water and wastewater capacity charges under existing rates and charges will be insufficient to recover a fair and proportional share of the cost to provide capacity; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mariposa Public Utility District Board of Directors that the capacity charges for a single-family residence wishing to connect to the public water and wastewater system are set as follows:

Single-Family Residence	\$6,250	\$5,823
Multi-Family Residential, Small Business (1:2)	\$6,250 / 2 units	\$ 5,823 / 2 units
Commercial No. 1 (1:2)	\$6,250 / 2 units	\$5,823 / 2 units
Commercial No. 2 (2:1)	\$12,500	\$11,646
Commercial No. 3 (3:1)	\$18,750	\$17,469
Commercial No. 4 (4:1)	\$25,000	\$23,292
Motels (1:3)	\$6,250 / 3 rooms	\$5,823 / 3 rooms

*Water system connections which benefit from the 1 MG water storage tank on Hospital Road pay an additional \$755 to offset debt service.

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the capacity charge for water and wastewater services be no less than the single-family residence equivalent; and

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is effective as of February 1, 2020 and supersedes Resolution No. 91-1130 and Ordinance No. 33; and

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the capacity charges set by this resolution are expressly intended to supersede and preempt the provisions of Ordinance 33 to the extent the same sets any connection or capacity charge that is different than the charge set by this resolution; and

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no person shall connect to the District public water and wastewater system until that person has obtained a permit from the Manager of the District; and

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the project proponent is responsible for construction costs to extend mains and laterals as required to meet District requirements for any connection to public water and or wastewater services.
