BROWN ACT GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 54952.7

Government Code section 54952.7 mandates the District provide a copy of Chapter 9 to any person elected or appointed to serve as a member of the legislative body of the District. Chapter 9 of the Government Code, known as Ralph M. Brown Act, was included in the meeting binder in paper format and electronically as a portable file document.

CROSS-CONNECTION CONTROL PROGRAM

The General Manager provided a progress update on cross-connection hazard assessments. The proposed residential self-survey for cross-connections was reviewed and will be distributed to residential customers who do not currently have premises containment using a backflow prevention assembly.

Although the District does not employ a permanent or contracted cross-connection control specialist, it must hire one to review every initial and follow-up hazard assessment and provide a written report. The Board reviewed a draft Request for Proposals, which will be advertised once most of the hazard assessments are finished.

The Board reviewed the draft Stockton Creek Preserve Recreation and Resilience Enhancement Master Plan which included maps and information regarding future development of hiking trails, picnic areas, bathrooms, as well as fire suppression projects.
